

David Dunaway – Jacksonville High football and track athlete in the early 1960s who played wide receiver at Duke and earned All-ACC honors in 1966. At Jacksonville High School, he helped win runner-up finishes in the state championships as a junior and senior. In 1962, he tied state records to win the 100- and 200- yard dashes and tied for first (getting third place) in the high jump. In 1963, he accounted for all of Jacksonville's 17 points, setting state records to win the 100, 220, and the high jump. After his career at Duke, he was drafted in the second round by the Green Bay Packers in 1967 and played two seasons in the NFL with the Packers, Atlanta Falcons and the New York Giants.
