Upon graduation, Quincy accepted a football scholarship to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill where he played linebacker. Continuing with high level of play, Quincy received numerous awards during his collegiate years as well. A very successful 4-year career culminated with a win over Auburn in the Chick-fil-A Peach Bowl his senior year. Quincy was able to take his game to the next level when he was drafted in the 7th round of the NFL by the New York Giants.
