

Gid Johnson – a successful coach in football, baseball and track at Georgetown High School and Jacksonville High School. He began his coaching career at Georgetown High School in 1953 and then moved to Jacksonville High School in 1966 after Georgetown was closed. He was influential in the transition during integration of the school system. In 1984 he retired. His Georgetown team won the North Carolina High School Athletic Conference State 2-A football championship in 1955, which was Onslow County's first state football title for any school. He was a member of the Jacksonville staff that produced the second state football title for Onslow County. That came in 1982 with the win by Jacksonville High School over Greensboro Page and captured the State's 4-A championship.
